I, Philip J. Hirschkop, having first been duly sworn, do hereby state as follows.

1. I am one of the attorneys representing defendant People for the Ethical Treatment of Animals, Inc. ("PeTA") in this action. I make this affidavit in support of defendant's Petition for Attorney's Fees pursuant to Fed. R. Civ. P. 54(d). I make these statements based upon my own personal knowledge, information and belief and am competent to testify hereto.

1 - AFFIDAVIT OF PHILIP J. HIRSCHKOP IN SUPPORT OF PETITION FOR ATTORNEY'S FEES

2. Defendants are entitled to recover attorneys' fees and litigation expenses pursuant to ORS 30.144(3), which provides as follows:

“A defendant who prevails on a special motion to strike made under ORS 30.142 shall be awarded reasonable attorney fees and costs.”

3. The number of hours for services rendered by me in this matter, listed by the time keeper at Hirschkop & Associates, P.C., is 11.6 hours, and my standard hourly rate is \$350.00, totaling \$4,060.00. Attached as Exhibit A is a computer generated statement showing the detailed time entries and descriptions of the services provided in this matter through June 19, 2007.

4. The hourly rates charged by me as set forth above is my standard hourly rates on matters of this kind in effect at the time the services were performed. The attorney's fees charged in this matter are appropriate considering the issues involved, the amount in controversy, and the experience of the lawyer involved. I believe the charges are appropriate in view of the fees that would be charged by other firms in the Washington D.C. Metropolitan Area for similar services by attorneys with similar experience.



I have been an Adjunct Professor of Law at Georgetown University Law Center, and a Professorial Lecturer at George Washington University Law School. My law practice has involved many cases of local and national interest as set forth on the attached curriculum vita. I have regularly charged and collected the standard hourly rate sought herein.

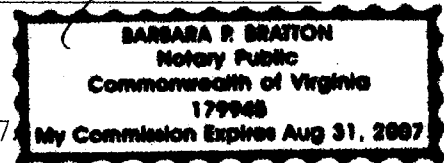
6. I have served as PeTA's counsel for litigation and other substantial legal matters for over 25 years. My review and consultation on this matter was done in the normal course of business with PeTA.
